






**STC Master Plan Summary of Scope and Progress to Date**

<u>Need:</u> The layout, functionality, and customer experience of the state's busiest transportation center requires evaluation for improvements.

<u>Purpose:</u> Provide recommendations and conceptual improvements that will lead to increased public and private transit use and enhanced access.

<u>Goal:</u> Develop a Master Plan that provides a new *vision* for the Stamford Transportation Center, transforming the complex into a best-in-class facility.


